One new initiative that will continue into the new year is our work on the LGBT Refugee Program. Partnering with HIAS of Pa and the William Way Community Center, we are offering free membership and participation in club activities to LGBT refugees resettling in the Philadelphia region. We are also pairing up each participant in the program with a Falcons ambassador to help welcome them to the club. We are working towards getting three refugees, identified by HIAS, to join the club in the new year.

There is so much to look forward to in 2018. We are planning to send one men's team and one women's team to the Gay Games in Paris this August where the Philadelphia Falcons will compete against teams from all over the world. And we will also have opportunities for you to play soccer all year long here at home. See you on the pitch in 2018!

LGBT Refugee Program

In 2017 we partnered with the William Way Community Center and HIAS PA, to offer a safe space for LGBT refugees to become members of our club and participate in our leagues and events free of charge. We recognize that LGBT refugees face many challenges when resettling in our community, but they will help it to thrive through their unique experiences and talents.

We have already raised money through GoFundMe that will be used to supply our program participants with free Falcons membership for one year, participation in our intra-Club seasonal leagues at no cost, free participation in our annual Liberty Bell Classic tournament and extra funds for transportation and/or participation in a city-wide league with a Falcons team. In 2018 we will focus on identifying participants interested in joining the Falcons.

Updated By Laws


Overview of Major Changes (please note, that all changes were voted on by the whole club):
